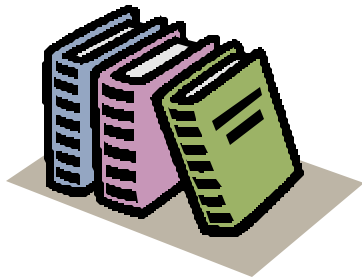


# L.O.V @ Your Library!
