


Lots of Love Stories




- **The Infinite Moment of Us** (Lauren Myracle) **YA MYRACLE**


- **Just One Year** (Gayle Forman) **YA FORMAN**
 - After spending an amazing day and night with a nameless girl in Paris, Willem embarks on his own transformative journey to find her once again.




- **These Broken Stars** (Amie Kaufman) **YA KAUFMAN**
 - Two star-crossed lovers must fight for survival when they crash land on a seemingly uninhabited planet




- **One or Two Things I Learned about Love** (Dyan Sheldon) **YA SHELDON**


- **Isla and the Happily Ever After** (Stephanie Perkins) **YA PERKINS**


- **24 Girls in 7 Days** (Alex Bradley) **YA BRADLEY**


- **Beastly** (Alex Flinn) **YA FLINN**
