


# Thrillers


- **The Girl with the Wrong Name** (Barnabas Miller) **YA MILLER**


- **People Like Us** (Dana Mele) **YA MELE**


- **Miss Peregrine's Home for Peculiar Children** (Ransom Riggs) **YA RIGGS**


- **The Madman's Daughter** (Megan Shepherd) **YA SHEPHERD**
