Talk

Talking in a way that encourages children to talk and respond will help them understand what they later read.

Sing

Singing slows down language so that children can hear the smaller parts of the words.

Read

Shared reading (interactive reading) is the single most important activity to help children get ready to read.

Write

Reading and writing both represent spoken language. Early writing begins with fine and gross motor skills - those scribbles and doodles are an important step in learning to write.

Play

Symbolic play (using one object to represent another), dramatic play (acting out and retelling stories), and role playing help children learn to express themselves and connect to their world.
